AT STANDARD (3-3.5)

This student regularly:

- follows class rules

APPROACHING STANDARD (2-2.5)

This student sometimes:

- focuses and engages in the class activity
- listens to and follows instructional directions and asks for help when needed
- follows class rules
- respects people and school property
- cooperates with others to accomplish lesson goals

NOT AT STANDARD (1-1.5)

This student seldom:

- focuses and engages in the class activity
- listens to and follows instructional directions and asks for help when needed
- follows class rules
- respects people and school property
- cooperates with others to accomplish lesson goals

Music:

- Students are expected to follow the “Music Star Agreements”:
1) Enter/exit quietly, 2) Mutual respect/safety, 3) Active listening, and most importantly 4) Participate with ENTHUSIASM! Another one of our sayings is, “Be a performer, not a show-off.”
- The music grade (1-4) is based on effort, and following the “star” agreements and our school rules: Work Hard, Be Kind, Be Safe.
